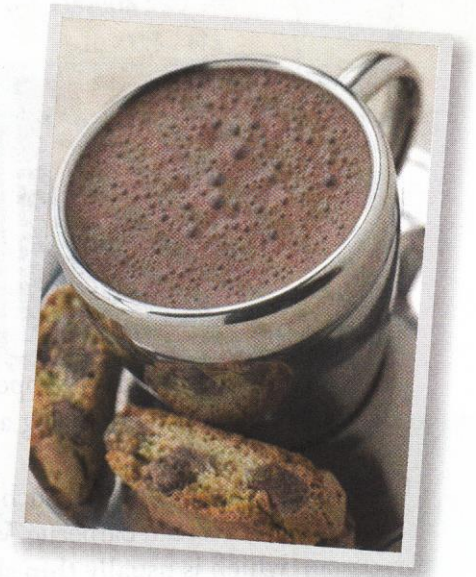

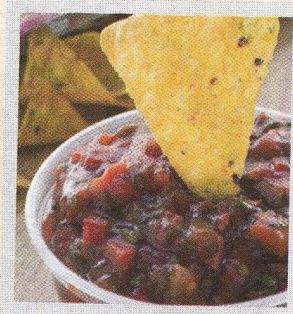

Apple crumble

Ingredients:

1 kg oranges

1kg apples

2 table spoons orange juice

3 table spoons orange juice

50 g brown sugar

60 g brown sugar

Crumble:

90 g butter

90 g margarine

180 g rye flour

180 g flour

60 g brown sugar

60 g sugar

Preparation:

Put the apples into an Owen dish; cover with the crumble.

Peel and cut the apples, add orange juice, brown sugar and cinnamon.

The crumble; mix the flour and the butter with your fingers; add the sugar.

Bake for 40 min, serve with vanilla sauce.
